



What's In A House?

This two-day back-to-back program weaves four components into an interdisciplinary hands-on extravaganza.

The Program Includes:

- A docent-guided tour of the Rosen House collection with additional thought-provoking commentary by a professional architect.
- A musician talking about his/her instrument and profession, then leading small student groups through creating and performing their own composition.
- An architect discussing building principles, then guiding the group through creating.
- Their own structures using hundreds of colorful blocks while listening to various styles of music.
- A master horticulturist offering a multi-sensory experience of exploring herbs & herbal teas.
- A drawing exercise in the colorful grandeur of the Music Room accompanied by live music.



Before The Visit:

An architect provides an in-school visit to introduce students to the profession of architecture. The teacher receives laminated reproductions of selected art from Caramoor's collection, "learning to look" questions, and a workbook with preparatory and follow-up exercises..
